Greenwich Bay Women's Club, a state-chartered, non-profit civic organization based in East Greenwich, RI, is committed to community service through monetary distributions and "in-kind" donations. Between 400 and 500 children ages 2 through 12 attend annually. All event proceeds are donated to several local charitable organizations, among which are Bayside Family Healthcare, Barbara M Tufts Co-op Preschool, Habitat for Humanity of West Bay and Northern RI, House of Hope, RI Meals on Wheels, and the East Greenwich Ecumenical Food Cupboard. We also provide educational scholarships for area residents.

One of the biggest expenses for Clown Town is prizes. In addition to first place prizes, consolation prizes are given out at all the games. Many promotional items such as markers, pens, pencils, sun glasses, water bottles, baseball caps, tee shirts, posters make wonderful prizes while larger items are good door prizes.
